Sue asked for the Secretary and Treasurer's reports. Aggie Hansen moved the Secretary's Report be approved as presented in Friend's newsletter, second by Nancy Bollard, motion carried. Jean Larson gave the Treasurer's Report in the absence of Torrie Harding. Motion by Barbara Grillo to approve same, second by Aggie Hansen, motion carried. We are reminded that annual membership dues are payable by July 1st. The cost of membership has remained the same since the Pine Library Friends originated. In Torrie's report she suggested maybe it's time for an increase. Fees are currently \$7 for an individual, \$10 per family, and \$100 for a lifetime membership. An increase from \$7 to \$10 was suggested. The remaining membership fee to remain the same. A motion by Helen Palmer to increase an individual membership to \$10, second by Nancy Miller. Motion carried. The Treasurer will send reminders out in June.

An omission from the Secretary's report in April, was a request by Nancy Hubbs for funds to purchase a new ladder to be used in putting up the signs advertising the book sales. A motion was approved to allot up to \$200 to purchase same. We are now informed that a ladder was donated so the funds were not needed.

An ice chest was donated by Becky Waer for the May book sale raffle. It was decided that due to success of prior raffles the ice chest would contain beer, wine, snacks etc.

The library is in need of a new vacuume, and we need to keep that in mind for a later date.
