Secretary's Report:

Minutes of Library Friend's meeting February 24, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. By President Sue Hedman. Those in attendance rose to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Sue then treated the group to a joke followed by words to make us ponder.

Debbie Tamietti introduced our speaker, acting County Assessor, Joseph Williams. He explained how our tax bill is developed and then answered questions from the group.

After the presentation, the group temporarily adjourned for refreshments.

The meeting was recalled to order and the treasurer, Carol Trimble, reviewed her report. Included in the report was our annual average income, (\$4000 to \$4200) and an approximate review of expenditures (\$3800).

Aggie Hansen explained the need for yearly binders which the library uses for Arizona Highways. She recommends purchasing 5 of them for the cost of \$60.00. Betsy Porter moved to approve the purchase and after seconding by Debbie Tamietti, the motion passed. Further discussion was held in regards to our average annual expenses and income.

Paying for the annual carpet cleaning was moved by Nancy Bollard and seconded by Jane Hock and approved by members. It is estimated to cost approximately \$1200-\$1500.

Two monthly expenses were approved for a six month period and to be reevaluated in July. They are cleaning services for the library for one hour a week at \$25.00 an hour. The second item is \$100 per month for the purchase of DVDs. Sharon Balentine moved that we provide these items. Aggie Hansen seconded it.

Finally it was moved by Helen Palmer and seconded by Aggie Hansen that the treasurer's report be accepted.

The motion passed.

Miscellaneous Business:

More volunteers are needed to help provide treats for the meetings.

Sharon Balentine thanked the group for their contributions to the Food Bank prior to the holidays.
